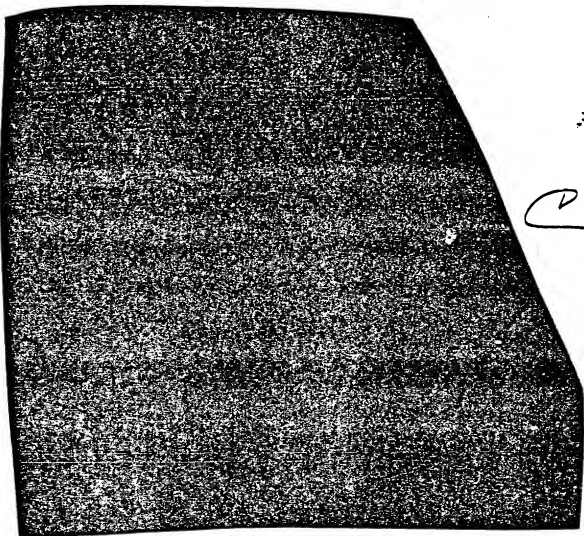
1. [REDACTED] Is one of the outstanding pharmacologist in the United States today. He has been widely honored for his work in penicillin and is [REDACTED]
