SUBJECT: SI and II Experimentation, 17 February 1953.

On Tuesday, 17 February 1953, [REDACTED] and the writer conducted II experimentation and tests with [REDACTED], [REDACTED], and [REDACTED]. Since Mr. [REDACTED] has had a considerable background of work (although she is not an exceptionally good subject), [REDACTED] and the writer decided to concentrate on improving the performance of both [REDACTED] and Mr. [REDACTED], who had merely started the work.

In this connection, a number of induction tests were run and both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] responded excellently. In view of this, it was decided to try more advanced work and both were tested on opening their eyes and remaining in a controlled state. This was carried out successfully and after discussion, first tests of normal movement were carried on. Each individual was able to open her eyes, walk, talk, and move freely about the experimental area. Their activities were very close to normal and for matter of record, it should be noted that both subjects are now approaching a point where very advanced work can be attempted with them.

[REDACTED] was simply run on several induction tests successfully and was used as an observer during most of the experimentation.

It should be noted for matter of record that both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] had been given a direct PH command at the previous session and both responded precisely and exactly to the PH as given after the lapse of one week's time.
