BLUE-BLACK COLOR. ONE END OF THIS OBJECT IS ROUND AND HEAVY
(AOL - LIKE A CANNON BALL). THIS OBJECT IS EITHER A PART OF, OR
ORIGINATES FROM A LONG, METALLIC CYLINDER. THERE IS A ROARING,
RUMBLING, THUNDER-LIKE SOUND ASSOCIATED WITH THIS OBJECT OR
THE EVENT.

ASSOCIATED WITH THE EVENT ARE THE COLORS RED, PINK, ^{AND} GREEN ON
A DARK, BLACK BACKGROUND. ALSO, ARCH-LIKE AND SQUARE/RECTANGULAR
DARK AREAS AGAINST A GREY BACKGROUND (AOL - LIKE DOORWAYS).
