Your FAX came through just fine directly into my Mac - hopefully it will work as well at your end for this one.

Re your listing, we have all of the documents here except the two (#3 & #11) from the open literature (which I assume are readily available at one of the local university or government libraries) and #4 which we do not have in either a classified or sanitized version (did you include the sanitized version in your FedEx to [redacted] A couple of minor discrepancies - I think the date on our version of #2 is Dec 88 - vice 89 on your list - but are probably the same document. I also assume #6 is the version we have dated Apr 89.

I was unaware that [redacted] building has a separate address which can be used if the recipient will personally sign for the package.
