CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-
3 tive day of Thursday, January 6, 2005, on a motion of-
4 fered pursuant to this concurrent resolution by its Major-
5 ity Leader or his designee, it stand adjourned until 10

1 a.m. on Thursday, January 20, 2005, or until the time
2 of any reassembly pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent
3 resolution, whichever occurs first; that when the House
4 adjourns on the legislative day of Thursday, January 20,
5 2005, it stand adjourned until 2 p.m. on Tuesday, Janu-
6 ary 25, 2005, or until the time of any reassembly pursuant
7 to section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs
8 first; and that when the Senate recesses or adjourns on
9 Thursday, January 6, 2005, or Friday, January 7, 2005,
10 on a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent resolution
11 by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand recessed
12 or adjourned until noon on Thursday, January 20, 2005,
13 or at such other time on that day as may be specified by
14 its Majority Leader or his designee in the motion to recess
15 or adjourn, or until the time of any reassembly pursuant
16 to section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs
17 first.

18 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
19 Leader of the Senate, or their respective designees, acting
20 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the
21 House and the Minority Leader of the Senate, shall notify
22 the Members of the House and the Senate, respectively,
23 to reassemble at such place and time as they may des-

1 ignate whenever, in their opinion, the public interest shall
2 warrant it.
