CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for the sine die adjournment of the first session
of the One Hundred Ninth Congress.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on any legisla-
3 tive day from Sunday, December 18, 2005, through Satur-
4 day, December 24, 2005, or from Monday, December 26,
5 2005, through Saturday, December 31, 2005, on a mo-
6 tion

1 offered pursuant to this concurrent resolution by its Ma-
2 jority Leader or his designee, it stand adjourned sine die
3 or until the time of any reassembly pursuant to section
4 3 of this concurrent resolution; and when the Senate ad-
5 journs on any day from Monday, December 19, 2005,
6 through Saturday, December 24, 2005, or from Monday,
7 December 26, 2005, through Saturday, December 31,
8 2005, on a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent res-
9 olution by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand
10 adjourned sine die or until the time of any reassembly pur-
11 suant to section 3 of this concurrent resolution.

12 SEC. 2. When the House adjourns on any legislative
13 day of the second session of the One Hundred Ninth Con-
14 gress from Tuesday, January 3, 2006, through Saturday,
15 January 28, 2006, on a motion offered pursuant to this
16 concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader or his des-
17 ignee, it shall stand adjourned until noon on Tuesday,
18 January 31, 2006, or until the time of any reassembly
19 pursuant to section 3 of this concurrent resolution, which-
20 ever occurs first; when the Senate recesses or adjourns
21 on any day of the second session of the One Hundred
22 Ninth Congress from Tuesday, January 3, 2006, through
23 Monday, January 16, 2006, on a motion offered pursuant
24 to this concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader or his
25 designee, it shall stand recessed or adjourned until noon

1 on Wednesday, January 18, 2006, or until such other time
2 on that day as may be specified by its Majority Leader
3 or his designee in the motion to recess or adjourn, or until
4 the time of any reassembly pursuant to section 3 of this
5 concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first; and when
6 the Senate recesses or adjourns on any day from Friday,
7 January 20, 2006, through Saturday, January 28, 2006,
8 on a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent resolution
9 by its Majority Leader or his designee, it shall stand re-
10 cessed or adjourned until noon on Tuesday, January 31,
11 2006, or until such other time on that day as may be spec-
12 ified by its Majority Leader or his designee in the motion
13 to recess or adjourn, or until the time of any reassembly
14 pursuant to section 3 of this concurrent resolution, which-
15 ever occurs first.

16 SEC. 3. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
17 Leader of the Senate, or their respective designees, acting
18 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the
19 House and the Minority Leader of the Senate, shall notify
20 the Members of the House and the Senate, respectively,
21 to reassemble at such place and time as they may

1 designate if, in their opinion, the public interest shall war-
2 rant it.
