CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment of the House of Representatives.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-
3 tive day of Wednesday, February 1, 2006, on a motion
4 offered pursuant to this concurrent resolution by its Ma-
5 jority Leader or his designee, it stand adjourned until 2

1 p.m. on Tuesday, February 7, 2006, or until the time of
2 any reassembly pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent
3 resolution, whichever occurs first; and that when the
4 House adjourns on the legislative day of Wednesday, Feb-
5 ruary 8, 2006, or Thursday, February 9, 2006, on a mo-
6 tion offered pursuant to this concurrent resolution by its
7 Majority Leader or his designee, it stand adjourned until
8 2 p.m. on Tuesday, February 14, 2006, or until the time
9 of any reassembly pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent
10 resolution, whichever occurs first.

11 SEC. 2. The Speaker or his designee, after consulta-
12 tion with the Minority Leader, shall notify the Members
13 of the House to reassemble at such place and time as he
14 may designate if, in his opinion, the public interest shall
15 warrant it.
