CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment of the House of Representatives and a conditional recess or adjournment of the Senate.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-
3 tive day of Thursday, February 16, 2006, on a motion
4 offered pursuant to this concurrent resolution by its Ma-
5 jority Leader or his designee, it stand adjourned until 2

1 p.m. on Tuesday, February 28, 2006, or until the time
2 of any reassembly pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent
3 resolution, whichever occurs first; and that when the Sen-
4 ate recesses or adjourns on any day from Friday, Feb-
5 ruary 17, 2006, through Tuesday, February 21, 2006, on
6 a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent resolution
7 by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand recessed
8 or adjourned until noon on Monday, February 27, 2006,
9 or such other time on that day as may be specified by
10 its Majority Leader or his designee in the motion to recess
11 or adjourn, or until the time of any reassembly pursuant
12 to section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs
13 first.

14 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
15 Leader of the Senate, or their respective designees, acting
16 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the
17 House and the Minority Leader of the Senate, shall notify
18 the Members of the House and the Senate, respectively,
19 to reassemble at such place and time as they may des-

1 ignate if, in their opinion, the public interest shall warrant
2 it.
