## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the printing as a House document of “A History, Committee on the Judiciary, United States House of Representatives, 1813–2006”.

1        *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2        *concurring),*

3        **SECTION 1. PRINTING OF DOCUMENT.**

4        (a) IN GENERAL.—The document entitled “A His-  
5        tory, Committee on the Judiciary, United States House  
6        of Representatives, 1813–2006” (or the document of the

1 history of the Committee on the Judiciary which is pre-  
2 pared during the One Hundred Ninth Congress with such  
3 similar title as may be provided by the Committee), pre-  
4 pared under the direction of the Committee on the Judici-  
5 ary of the House of Representatives, shall be printed as  
6 a House document, with illustrations and suitable binding,  
7 in a style and manner determined by the Joint Committee  
8 on Printing.

9 (b) ADDITIONAL COPIES.—With respect to the docu-  
10 ment described in subsection (a), in addition to the usual  
11 number there shall be printed the lesser of—

12 (1) 200 copies, of which 60 shall be casebound  
13 for the use of Members of the Committee on the Ju-  
14 diciary; or

15 (2) the maximum number of copies for which  
16 the total production and printing cost does not ex-  
17 ceed \$7,000, with production and distribution to be  
18 allocated in the same proportion as described in  
19 paragraph (1).
