CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a correction to the enrollment of the
bill, S. 203.

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1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That in the enrollment of the bill, S. 203,
3 the Secretary of the Senate shall make the following cor-
4 rection: After section 702 insert the following new section
5 (and amend the table of contents accordingly):

1 **SEC. 703. NEW JERSEY COASTAL HERITAGE TRAIL ROUTE.**

2 (a) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Public
3 Law 100–515 (16 U.S.C. 1244 note) is amended by strik-
4 ing section 6 and inserting the following:

5 **“SEC. 6. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

6 “(a) IN GENERAL.—There are authorized to be ap-
7 propriated to the Secretary such sums as are necessary
8 to carry out this Act.

9 “(b) USE OF FUNDS.—

10 “(1) IN GENERAL.—Amounts made available
11 under subsection (a) shall be used only for—

12 “(A) technical assistance; and

13 “(B) the design and fabrication of inter-
14 pretative materials, devices, and signs.

15 “(2) LIMITATIONS.—No funds made available
16 under subsection (a) shall be used for—

17 “(A) operation, repair, or construction
18 costs, except for the costs of constructing inter-
19 pretative exhibits; or

20 “(B) operation, maintenance, or repair
21 costs for any road or related structure.

22 “(3) COST-SHARING REQUIREMENT.—

23 “(A) FEDERAL SHARE.—The Federal
24 share of any project carried out with amounts
25 made available under subsection (a)—

1 “(i) may not exceed 50 percent of the
2 total project costs; and

3 “(ii) shall be provided on a matching
4 basis.

5 “(B) FORM OF NON-FEDERAL SHARE.—
6 The non-Federal share of carrying out a project
7 with amounts made available under subsection
8 (a) may be in the form of cash, materials, or
9 in-kind services, the value of which shall be de-
10 termined by the Secretary.

11 “(c) TERMINATION OF AUTHORITY.—The authorities
12 provided to the Secretary under this Act shall terminate
13 on September 30, 2007.”.

14 (b) STRATEGIC PLAN.—

15 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 3 years after
16 the date on which funds are made available, the Sec-
17 retary of the Interior shall prepare a strategic plan
18 for the New Jersey Coastal Heritage Trail Route.

19 (2) CONTENTS.—The strategic plan shall de-
20 scribe—

21 (A) opportunities to increase participation
22 by national and local private and public inter-
23 ests in the planning, development, and adminis-
24 tration of the New Jersey Coastal Heritage
25 Trail Route; and

1 (B) organizational options for sustaining
2 the New Jersey Coastal Heritage Trail Route.
