CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment of the House of Representatives and a conditional recess or adjournment of the Senate.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on any day
3 from Wednesday, August 2, 2006, through Tuesday, Au-
4 gust 8, 2006, on a motion offered pursuant to this concur-
5 rent resolution by its Majority Leader or his designee, it

1 stand adjourned until 2 p.m. on Wednesday, September
2 6, 2006, or until the time of any reassembly pursuant to
3 section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs
4 first; and that when the Senate recesses or adjourns on
5 any day from Thursday, August 3, 2006, through Tues-
6 day, August 8, 2006, on a motion offered pursuant to this
7 concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader or his des-
8 ignee, it stand recessed or adjourned until noon on Tues-
9 day, September 5, 2006, or such other time on that day
10 as may be specified by its Majority Leader or his designee
11 in the motion to recess or adjourn, or until the time of
12 any reassembly pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent
13 resolution, whichever occurs first.

14 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
15 Leader of the Senate, or their respective designees, acting
16 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the
17 House and the Minority Leader of the Senate, shall notify
18 the Members of the House and the Senate, respectively,
19 to reassemble at such place and time as they may

1 designate if, in their opinion, the public interest shall war-
2 rant it.
