CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the printing as a House document of “United States House of Representatives, The Committee on Ways and Means: A History, 1789–2006”.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring),*

3 **SECTION 1. PRINTING OF DOCUMENT.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The document entitled “United
5 States House of Representatives, The Committee on Ways
6 and Means: A History, 1789–2006”, prepared under the
7 direction of the Office of the Historian, United States
8 House of Representatives, shall be printed as a House doc-
9 ument, with illustrations and suitable binding, in a style

1 and manner determined by the Joint Committee on Print-
2 ing.

3 (b) ADDITIONAL COPIES.—With respect to the docu-
4 ment described in subsection (a), in addition to the usual
5 number there shall be printed the lesser of—

6 (1) 1,500 copies, of which 50 shall be bound in
7 leather for the use of Members of the Committee on
8 Ways and Means and 500 shall be casebound for
9 distribution by the Committee on Ways and Means;
10 or

11 (2) the maximum number of copies for which
12 the total production and printing cost does not ex-
13 ceed \$40,000, with production and distribution to be
14 allocated in the same proportion as described in
15 paragraph (1).
