CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment of the House of Representatives and a conditional recess or adjournment of the Senate.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-
3 tive day of Wednesday, November 15, 2006, Thursday,
4 November 16, 2006, or Friday, November 17, 2006, on
5 a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent resolution
6 by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand adjourned

1 until 10 a.m. on Tuesday, December 5, 2006, or until the
2 time of any reassembly pursuant to section 2 of this con-
3 current resolution, whichever occurs first; and that when
4 the Senate recesses or adjourns on Thursday, November
5 16, 2006, or Friday, November 17, 2006, on a motion of-
6 fered pursuant to this concurrent resolution by its Major-
7 ity Leader or his designee, it stand recessed or adjourned
8 until noon on Monday, December 4, 2006, or Tuesday,
9 December 5, 2006, as may be specified by its Majority
10 Leader or his designee in the motion to recess or adjourn,
11 or such other time on that day as may be specified by
12 its Majority Leader or his designee in the motion to recess
13 or adjourn, or until the time of any reassembly pursuant
14 to section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs
15 first.

16 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
17 Leader of the Senate, or their respective designees, acting
18 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the
19 House and the Minority Leader of the Senate, shall notify
20 the Members of the House and the Senate, respectively,
21 to reassemble at such place and time as they may

1 designate if, in their opinion, the public interest shall war-
2 rant it.
