1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring),*

1 **SECTION 1. USE OF ROTUNDA FOR HOLOCAUST DAYS OF**
2 **REMEMBRANCE CEREMONY.**

3 The rotunda of the Capitol is authorized to be used
4 on May 5, 2005, for a ceremony as part of the commemo-
5 ration of the days of remembrance of victims of the Holo-
6 caust. Physical preparations for the ceremony shall be car-
7 ried out in accordance with such conditions as the Archi-
8 tect of the Capitol may prescribe.
