## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Permitting the use of the rotunda of the Capitol for a ceremony to award a Congressional gold medal to Jackie Robinson (posthumously), in recognition of his many contributions to the Nation.

2 *concurring)*, That the rotunda of the Capitol is authorized  
3 to be used on March 2, 2005, for a ceremony to award  
4 a Congressional gold medal to Jackie Robinson (post-  
5 humously), in recognition of his many contributions to the

1 Nation. Physical preparations for the ceremony shall be  
2 carried out in accordance with such conditions as the Ar-  
3 chitect of the Capitol may prescribe.
