Mr. SAM JOHNSON of Texas (for himself and Mr. REGULA) introduced the
following joint resolution; which was referred to the Committee on House
Administration

JOINT RESOLUTION

Providing for the appointment of Shirley Ann Jackson as
a citizen regent of the Board of Regents of the Smithso-
nian Institution.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That in accordance with section 5581 of the Revised Stat-
4 utes of the United States (20 U.S.C. 43), the vacancy on
5 the Board of Regents of the Smithsonian Institution, in
6 the class other than Members of Congress, occurring by
7 reason of the expiration of the term of Hanna H. Gray
8 of Illinois on April 13, 2005, is filled by the appointment
9 of Shirley Ann Jackson of New York. The appointment

1 is for a term of 6 years, beginning on the later of April
2 14, 2005, or the date of the enactment of this joint resolu-
3 tion.
