5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States

6 Postal Service located at 301 South Heatherwilde Boule-

7 vard in Pflugerville, Texas, shall be known and designated

1 as the “Sergeant Byron W. Norwood Post Office Build-
2 ing”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the “Sergeant Byron W.
7 Norwood Post Office Building”.
