2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF JUDGE EMILIO VARGAS POST**
2 **OFFICE BUILDING.**

3 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
4 Postal Service located at 151 West End Street in Goliad,
5 Texas, shall be known and designated as the “Judge
6 Emilio Vargas Post Office Building”.

7 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
8 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
9 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
10 be deemed to be a reference to the “Judge Emilio Vargas
11 Post Office Building”.
