A BILL

To designate a Forest Service trail at Waldo Lake in the Willamette National Forest in the State of Oregon as a national recreation trail in honor of Jim Weaver, a former Member of the House of Representatives.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF NATIONAL RECREATIONAL**
2 **TRAIL, WILLAMETTE NATIONAL FOREST, OR-**
3 **EGON, IN HONOR OF JIM WEAVER, A FORMER**
4 **MEMBER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTA-**
5 **TIVES.**

6 (a) DESIGNATION.—Forest Service trail number
7 3590 in the Willamette National Forest in Lane County,
8 Oregon, which is a 19.6 mile trail that begins and ends
9 at North Waldo Campground and circumvents Waldo
10 Lake, is hereby designated as a national recreation trail
11 under section 4 of the National Trails System Act (16
12 U.S.C. 1243) and shall be known as the “Jim Weaver
13 Loop Trail”.

14 (b) INTERPRETIVE SIGN.—Using funds available for
15 the Forest Service, the Secretary of the Interior shall pre-
16 pare, install, and maintain an appropriate sign at the
17 trailhead of the Jim Weaver Loop Trail to indicate the
18 name of the trail and to provide information regarding the
19 life and career of Congressman Jim Weaver.
