Mr. HUNTER introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Resources

A BILL

To revoke a Public Land Order with respect to certain lands erroneously included in the Cibola National Wildlife Refuge, California.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REVOCATION OF PUBLIC LAND ORDER WITH**
4 **RESPECT TO LANDS ERRONEOUSLY IN-**
5 **CLUDED IN CIBOLA NATIONAL WILDLIFE**
6 **REFUGE, CALIFORNIA.**

7 Public Land Order 3442, dated August 21, 1964, is
8 revoked insofar as it applies to the following described
9 lands: San Bernardino Meridian, T11S, R22E, sec. 6, all
10 of lots 1, 16, and 17, and SE¹/₄ of SW¹/₄ in Imperial

1 County, California, aggregating approximately 140.32
2 acres.

3 **SEC. 2. RESURVEY AND NOTICE OF MODIFIED BOUND-**
4 **ARIES.**

5 The Secretary of the Interior shall, by not later than
6 6 months after the date of the enactment of this Act—

7 (1) resurvey the boundaries of the Cibola Na-
8 tional Wildlife Refuge, as modified by the revocation
9 under section 1;

10 (2) publish notice of, and post conspicuous
11 signs marking, the boundaries of the refuge deter-
12 mined in such resurvey; and

13 (3) prepare and publish a map showing the
14 boundaries of the refuge.

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
