AN ACT

To reauthorize the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families block grant program through June 30, 2005, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Welfare Reform Exten-
3 sion Act of 2005”.

4 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF THE TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE FOR**
5 **NEEDY FAMILIES BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM**
6 **THROUGH JUNE 30, 2005.**

7 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Activities authorized by part A of
8 title IV of the Social Security Act, and by sections 510,
9 1108(b), and 1925 of such Act, shall continue through
10 June 30, 2005, in the manner authorized for fiscal year
11 2004, notwithstanding section 1902(e)(1)(A) of such Act,
12 and out of any money in the Treasury of the United States
13 not otherwise appropriated, there are hereby appropriated
14 such sums as may be necessary for such purpose. Grants
15 and payments may be made pursuant to this authority
16 through the third quarter of fiscal year 2005 at the level
17 provided for such activities through the third quarter of
18 fiscal year 2004.

19 (b) **CONFORMING AMENDMENT.**—Section
20 403(a)(3)(H)(ii) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
21 603(a)(3)(H)(ii)) is amended by striking “March 31” and
22 inserting “June 30”.

1 **SEC. 3. EXTENSION OF THE NATIONAL RANDOM SAMPLE**
2 **STUDY OF CHILD WELFARE AND CHILD WEL-**
3 **FARE WAIVER AUTHORITY THROUGH JUNE**
4 **30, 2005.**

5 Activities authorized by sections 429A and 1130(a)
6 of the Social Security Act shall continue through June 30,
7 2005, in the manner authorized for fiscal year 2004, and
8 out of any money in the Treasury of the United States
9 not otherwise appropriated, there are hereby appropriated
10 such sums as may be necessary for such purpose. Grants
11 and payments may be made pursuant to this authority
12 through the third quarter of fiscal year 2005 at the level
13 provided for such activities through the third quarter of
14 fiscal year 2004.
