## A BILL

To amend the Truth in Regulating Act to make permanent  
the pilot project for the report on rules.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT OF TRUTH IN REGULATING ACT**

4 **TO MAKE PERMANENT PILOT PROJECT FOR**

5 **REPORT ON RULES.**

6 (a) PURPOSE.—The purpose of this section is to  
7 make permanent the authority to request the performance  
8 of regulatory analysis to enhance Congressional responsi-  
9 bility for regulatory decisions developed under the laws en-  
10 acted by Congress.

1 (b) AMENDMENT.—The Truth in Regulating Act of  
2 2000 (Public Law 106–312; 5 U.S.C. 801 note) is amend-  
3 ed—

4 (1) in the heading for section 4, by striking  
5 “**PILOT PROJECT FOR**”;

6 (2) by striking section 5 and redesignating sec-  
7 tion 6 as section 5; and

8 (3) in section 5 (as redesignated by paragraph  
9 (2))—

10 (A) in the heading, by striking “**AND DU-**  
11 **RATION OF PILOT PROJECT**”;

12 (B) in subsection (a), by striking “(a) EF-  
13 FECTIVE DATE.—”; and

14 (C) by striking subsections (b) and (c).
