2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CAPTAIN MARK STUBENHOFER POST OFFICE**
4 **BUILDING.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
6 Postal Service located at 6200 Rolling Road in Spring-

1 field, Virginia, shall be known and designated as the “Cap-
2 tain Mark Stubenhofer Post Office Building”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the “Captain Mark
7 Stubenhofer Post Office Building”.
