## AN ACT

To designate a portion of the Federal building located at 2100 Jamieson Avenue, in Alexandria, Virginia, as the “Justin W. Williams United States Attorney’s Building”.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—The building and structure de-  
3 scribed in subsection (b) shall be known and designated  
4 as the “Justin W. Williams United States Attorney’s  
5 Building”.

6 (b) DESCRIPTION.—The building and structure to be  
7 designated under subsection (a) is that portion of the Fed-  
8 eral building located at 2100 Jamieson Avenue, in Alexan-  
9 dria, Virginia, that is attached to the Federal building’s  
10 main tower structure, described as A-Wing in the architec-  
11 tural plans, and currently occupied by the Office of the  
12 United States Attorney for the Eastern District of Vir-  
13 ginia, Alexandria Division.

14 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

15 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,  
16 paper, or other record of the United States to the building  
17 and structure described in section 1(b) shall be deemed  
18 to be a reference to the “Justin W. Williams United States  
19 Attorney’s Building”.

20 **SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

21 There are authorized to be appropriated such sums  
22 as may be necessary for appropriate identifying designa-  
23 tions to be affixed to the building and structure described  
24 in section 1(b) and for an appropriate plaque reflecting  
25 the designation and honoring Justin W. Williams and his

- 1 service to the Nation to be affixed to or displayed in such
- 2 building and structure.
