2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. COASTAL RECREATION WATER QUALITY MONI-**  
2 **TORING AND NOTIFICATION.**

3 Section 406(i) of the Federal Water Pollution Control  
4 Act (33 U.S.C. 1346(i)) is amended by striking “2005”  
5 and inserting “2011”.

6 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

7 Section 8 of the Beaches Environmental Assessment  
8 and Coastal Health Act of 2000 (114 Stat. 877) is amend-  
9 ed by striking “2005” and inserting “2011”.
