

In the Senate of the United States,

September 6, 2006.

Resolved, That the bill from the House of Representatives (H.R. 2066) entitled “An Act to amend title 40, United States Code, to establish a Federal Acquisition Service, to replace the General Supply Fund and the Information Technology Fund with an Acquisition Services Fund, and for other purposes.”, do pass with the following

AMENDMENTS:

- 1 **(1)**Page 2, line 25, strike out [up to five]
- 2 **(2)**Page 10, line 7, strike out [or] and all that follows
- 3 through the end of line 9, and insert:

1 “(B) the exceptional difficulty in recruiting
2 or retaining a qualified employee, or

3 “(C) a temporary emergency hiring need,

4 **(3)**Page 10, line 20, strike out **【December 31, 2011.】**
5 and insert: *December 31, 2011.*”.

6 **(4)**Page 10, strike out line 21 and all that follows
7 through page 13, line 8, and insert the following new sec-
8 tion and renumber subsequent section:

9 **SEC. 5. DISPOSAL OF FEDERAL SURPLUS PROPERTY TO**
10 **HISTORIC LIGHT STATIONS.**

11 *Section 549(c)(3)(B) of title 40, United States Code,*
12 *is amended—*

13 (1) *in clause (vii), by striking “or” after the*
14 *semicolon;*

15 (2) *in clause (viii), by striking the period and*
16 *inserting “; or”; and*

17 (3) *by adding at the end the following:*

18 “(ix) *a historic light station as defined*
19 *under section 308(e)(2) of the National His-*
20 *toric Preservation Act (16 U.S.C. 470w-*
21 *7(e)(2)), including a historic light station*
22 *conveyed under subsection (b) of that sec-*
23 *tion, notwithstanding the number of hours*

1 *that the historic light station is open to the*
2 *public.”.*
