## A BILL

To make permanent the authority of the Secretary of Commerce to conduct the quarterly financial report program.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT AUTHORITY FOR SECRETARY OF**  
2 **COMMERCE TO CONDUCT THE QUARTERLY**  
3 **FINANCIAL REPORT PROGRAM.**

4 Section 4 of the Act entitled “An Act to amend title  
5 13, United States Code, to transfer responsibility for the  
6 quarterly financial report from the Federal Trade Com-  
7 mission to the Secretary of Commerce, and for other pur-  
8 poses”; approved January 12, 1983 (Public Law 97-454;  
9 13 U.S.C. 91 note), is amended by striking subsection (b).

10 **SECTION 1. TEN-YEAR EXTENSION OF AUTHORITY FOR SEC-**  
11 **RETARY OF COMMERCE TO CONDUCT THE**  
12 **QUARTERLY FINANCIAL REPORT PROGRAM.**

13 *Section 4(b) of the Act entitled “An Act to amend title*  
14 *13, United States Code, to transfer responsibility for the*  
15 *quarterly financial report from the Federal Trade Commis-*  
16 *sion to the Secretary of Commerce, and for other purposes”,*  
17 *approved January 12, 1983 (Public Law 97-454; 13 U.S.C.*  
18 *91 note), is amended by striking “2005” and inserting*  
19 *“2015”.*

Amend the title so as to read: “A bill to extend by  
10 years the authority of the Secretary of Commerce to  
conduct the quarterly financial report program.”.
