3 **SECTION 1. MAYOR JOSEPH S. DADDONA MEMORIAL POST**
4 **OFFICE.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
6 Postal Service located at 442 West Hamilton Street, Al-

1 lentown, Pennsylvania, shall be known and designated as
2 the “Mayor Joseph S. Daddona Memorial Post Office”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the “Mayor Joseph S.
7 Daddona Memorial Post Office”.
