1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. J.M. DIETRICH NORTHEAST ANNEX.**

4 (a) REDESIGNATION.—The facility of the United
5 States Postal Service located at 1927 Sangamon Avenue
6 in Springfield, Illinois, and known as the Northeast

1 Annex, shall be known and designated as the “J.M.
2 Dietrich Northeast Annex”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the “J.M. Dietrich North-
7 east Annex”.
