**AN ACT**

To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 102 South Walters Avenue in Hodgenville, Kentucky, as the “Abraham Lincoln Birthplace Post Office Building”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 The facility of the United States Postal Service lo-  
5 cated at 102 South Walters Avenue in Hodgenville, Ken-  
6 tucky, shall be known and designated as the “Abraham  
7 Lincoln Birthplace Post Office Building”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2       Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,  
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the facility  
4 referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a reference  
5 to the “Abraham Lincoln Birthplace Post Office Build-  
6 ing”.
