## AN ACT

To permit the individuals currently serving as Executive Director, Deputy Executive Directors, and General Counsel of the Office of Compliance to serve one additional term.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. PERMITTING CURRENT EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR,**  
2 **DEPUTY EXECUTIVE DIRECTORS, AND GEN-**  
3 **ERAL COUNSEL OF OFFICE OF COMPLIANCE**  
4 **TO SERVE ONE ADDITIONAL TERM.**

5 (a) **EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR.**—Notwithstanding sec-  
6 tion 302(a)(3) of the Congressional Accountability Act of  
7 1995 (2 U.S.C. 1382(a)(3)), the individual serving as Ex-  
8 ecutive Director of the Office of Compliance as of the date  
9 of the enactment of this Act may serve one additional  
10 term.

11 (b) **DEPUTY EXECUTIVE DIRECTORS.**—Notwith-  
12 standing section 302(b)(2) of such Act (2 U.S.C.  
13 1382(b)(2)), any individual serving as a Deputy Executive  
14 Director of the Office of Compliance as of the date of the  
15 enactment of this Act may serve one additional term.

16 (c) **GENERAL COUNSEL.**—Notwithstanding section  
17 302(c)(5) of such Act (2 U.S.C. 1382(c)(5)), the indi-  
18 vidual serving as General Counsel of the Office of Compli-  
19 ance as of the date of the enactment of this Act may serve  
20 one additional term.
