1 **SECTION 1. ARTHUR STACEY MASTRAPA POST OFFICE**
2 **BUILDING.**

3 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
4 Postal Service located at 321 Montgomery Road in
5 Altamonte Springs, Florida, shall be known and des-
6 ignated as the “Arthur Stacey Mastrapa Post Office
7 Building”.

8 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
9 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
10 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
11 be deemed to be a reference to the Arthur Stacey
12 Mastrapa Post Office Building.
