A BILL

To amend the Yuma Crossing National Heritage Area Act of 2000 to adjust the boundary of the Yuma Crossing National Heritage Area and to extend the authority of the Secretary of the Interior to provide assistance under that Act.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. YUMA CROSSING NATIONAL HERITAGE AREA**

4 **BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENT.**

5 *Section 3(b) of the Yuma Crossing National Heritage*
6 *Area Act of 2000 (16 U.S.C. 461 note; Public Law 106-*
7 *319; 114 Stat. 1281) is amended to read as follows:*

8 “(b) *BOUNDARIES.—The Heritage Area shall comprise*
9 *the lands generally depicted on the map entitled ‘Yuma*
10 *Crossing National Heritage Area Boundary Adjustment’,*
11 *numbered 903–80071, and dated October 16, 2005.’”.*

Amend the title so as to read: “A bill to amend the Yuma Crossing National Heritage Area Act of 2000 to adjust the boundary of the Yuma Crossing National Heritage Area and for other purposes.”.
