A BILL

1 **SECTION 1. NONIMMIGRANT TRADERS AND INVESTORS**
2 **FROM DENMARK.**

3 Denmark shall be considered, for purposes of section
4 101(a)(15)(E) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8
5 U.S.C. 1101(a)(15)(E)), to be a foreign state described
6 in such section if Denmark extends reciprocal non-
7 immigrant treatment to nationals of the United States.

8 **SECTION 1. NONIMMIGRANT TRADERS AND INVESTORS**
9 **FROM DENMARK.**

10 *Denmark shall be considered, for purposes of section*
11 *101(a)(15)(E) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8*
12 *U.S.C. 1101(a)(15)(E)), to be a foreign state described in*
13 *such section (other than clause (iii) of such section) if Den-*
14 *mark extends reciprocal nonimmigrant treatment to na-*
15 *tionals of the United States.*
