3 **SECTION 1. KARL MALDEN STATION.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
5 Postal Service located at 200 South Barrington Street in
6 Los Angeles, California, shall be known and designated
7 as the “Karl Malden Station”.

8 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
9 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United

- 1 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
- 2 be deemed to be a reference to the “Karl Malden Station”.
