A BILL

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. U.S. CLEVELAND POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
5 Postal Service located at 130 East Marion Avenue in

1 Punta Gorda, Florida, shall be known and designated as
2 the “U.S. Cleveland Post Office Building”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the “U.S. Cleveland Post
7 Office Building”.
