Mr. BAIRD introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Resources

A BILL

To designate a portion of the White Salmon River as a component of the National Wild and Scenic Rivers System.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Upper White Salmon
5 Wild and Scenic Rivers Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. UPPER WHITE SALMON WILD AND SCENIC RIVER.**

7 Section 3(a) of the Wild and Scenic Rivers Act (16
8 U.S.C. 1274(a)) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
9 lowing:

1 “() WHITE SALMON RIVER, WASHINGTON.—
2 The 20 miles of river segments of the main stem of
3 the White Salmon River and Cascade Creek, Wash-
4 ington, to be administered by the Secretary of Agri-
5 culture in the following classifications:

6 “(A) The approximately 1.6-mile segment
7 of the main stem of the White Salmon River
8 from the headwaters on Mount Adams in sec-
9 tion 17, township 8 north, range 10 east, down-
10 stream to the Mount Adams Wilderness bound-
11 ary as a wild river.

12 “(B) The approximately 5.1-mile segment
13 of Cascade Creek from its headwaters on Mount
14 Adams in section 10, township 8 north, range
15 10 east, downstream to the Mount Adams Wil-
16 derness boundary as a wild river.

17 “(C) The approximately 1.5-mile segment
18 of Cascade Creek from the Mount Adams Wil-
19 derness boundary downstream to its confluence
20 with the White Salmon River as a scenic river.

21 “(D) The approximately 11.8-mile segment
22 of the main stem of the White Salmon River
23 from the Mount Adams Wilderness boundary
24 downstream to the Gifford Pinchot National
25 Forest boundary as a scenic river.”.

1 **SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

2 There are authorized to be appropriated such sums

3 as are necessary to carry out this Act.
