Mr. MEEHAN introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Resources

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## A BILL

To adjust the boundary of Lowell National Historical Park,  
and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Lowell National His-  
5 torical Park Boundary Adjustment Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS.**

7 The Act entitled “An Act to provide for the establish-  
8 ment of the Lowell National Historical Park in the Com-  
9 monwealth of Massachusetts, and for other purposes” ap-

1 proved June 5, 1978 (Public Law 95–290; 92 Stat. 290;  
2 16 U.S.C. 410cc et seq.) is amended as follows:

3 (1) In section 101(a), by adding a new para-  
4 graph after paragraph (2) as follows:

5 “(3) The boundaries of the park are modified  
6 to include five parcels of land identified on the map  
7 entitled ‘Boundary Adjustment, Lowell National  
8 Historical Park,’ numbered 475/81,424B and dated  
9 September 2004, and as delineated in section  
10 202(a)(2)(G).”.

11 (2) In section 202(a)(2), by adding at the end  
12 the following new subparagraph:

13 “(G) The properties shown on the map  
14 identified in subsection (101)(a)(3) as follows:

15 “(i) 91 Pevey Street.

16 “(ii) The portion of 607 Middlesex  
17 Place.

18 “(iii) Eagle Court.

19 “(iv) The portion of 50 Payne Street.

20 “(v) 726 Broadway.”.

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
