2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. AUTHORITY FOR ESTABLISHING MEMORIAL EX-**
2 **TENDED.**

3 Section 1 of Public Law 106–348 is amended—

4 (1) in subsection (b), by adding at the end, be-
5 fore the final period, the following: “, except that
6 section 8903(e) of title 40, United States Code, shall
7 not apply and the authorization for this Act shall ex-
8 pire on October 24, 2015”; and

9 (2) in subsection (d), by striking “under section
10 10(b) of such Act (40 U.S.C. 1010(b))” and insert-
11 ing “under subsection (b)”.
