Mr. OTTER (for himself and Mr. SIMPSON) introduced the following bill; which
was referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce

A BILL

To extend the time required for construction of a
hydroelectric project, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ARROWROCK HYDROELECTRIC PROJECT.**

4 Notwithstanding the time period specified in section
5 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806) that would
6 otherwise apply to the Federal Energy Regulatory Com-
7 mission project numbered 4656, on request of the licensee,
8 the Commission shall—

9 (1) if the license for the project is in effect on
10 the date of the enactment of this Act, extend the pe-

1 riod for commencing construction of project works
2 for a period of 3 years beginning on the date of en-
3 actment of this Act; or

4 (2) if the license for the project has been termi-
5 nated before the date of enactment of this Act, rein-
6 state the license and extend the period for com-
7 mencing construction of project works for an addi-
8 tional 3-year period beginning on the date of enact-
9 ment of this Act.
