A BILL

To extend the time required for construction of a hydroelectric project, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. ARROWROCK HYDROELECTRIC PROJECT.**

2 Notwithstanding the time period specified in section
3 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806) that would
4 otherwise apply to the Federal Energy Regulatory Com-
5 mission project numbered 4656, on request of the licensee,
6 the Commission shall—

7 (1) if the license for the project is in effect on
8 the date of the enactment of this Act, extend the pe-
9 riod for commencing construction of project works
10 for a period of 3 years beginning on the date of en-
11 actment of this Act; or

12 (2) if the license for the project has been termi-
13 nated before the date of enactment of this Act, rein-
14 state the license and extend the period for com-
15 mencing construction of project works for an addi-
16 tional 3-year period beginning on the date of enact-
17 ment of this Act.
