A BILL

To provide for the reinstatement of a license for a certain
Federal Energy Regulatory project.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSE FOR FEDERAL**
4 **ENERGY REGULATORY COMMISSION**
5 **PROJECT.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding the time period
7 specified in section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16
8 U.S.C. 806) that would otherwise apply to project num-
9 bered 7307 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commis-
10 sion, the Commission shall, upon the request of the li-

1 censee for the project, in accordance with that section (in-
2 cluding the good faith, due diligence, and public interest
3 requirements of that section and the procedures estab-
4 lished under that section), extend the time required for
5 commencement of construction of the project until Decem-
6 ber 31, 2007.

7 (b) APPLICABILITY.—Subsection (a) shall apply to
8 the project upon the expiration of any extension, issued
9 by the Commission under section 13 of the Federal Power
10 Act (16 U.S.C. 806), of the time required for commence-
11 ment of construction of the project.

12 (c) REINSTATEMENT OF EXPIRED LICENSE.—If a li-
13 cense of the Commission for the project expires before the
14 date of enactment of this Act, the Commission shall—

15 (1) reinstate the license effective as of the date
16 of the expiration of the license; and

17 (2) extend the time required for commencement
18 of construction of the project until December 31,
19 2007.
