3 **SECTION 1. HATTIE CARAWAY STATION.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
5 Postal Service located at 2404 Race Street in Jonesboro,
6 Arkansas, shall be known and designated as the “Hattie
7 Caraway Station”.

8 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
9 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United

1 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
2 be deemed to be a reference to the “Hattie Caraway Sta-
3 tion”.
