A BILL

To temporarily extend the programs under the Higher Education Act of 1965, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Second Higher Edu-
5 cation Extension Act of 2005”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF PROGRAMS.**

7 (a) GENERAL EXTENSION.—Section 2(a) of the
8 Higher Education Extension Act of 2005 (Public Law

1 109–81; 20 U.S.C. 1001 note) is amended by striking
2 “December 31, 2005” and inserting “March 31, 2006”.

3 (b) EXTENSION OF LIMITATIONS ON SPECIAL AL-
4 LOWANCE FOR LOANS FROM THE PROCEEDS OF TAX EX-
5 EMPT ISSUES.—Section 438(b)(2)(B) of the Higher Edu-
6 cation Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1087–1(b)(2)(B)) is
7 amended by striking “January 1, 2006” each place it ap-
8 pears in clauses (iv) and (v)(II) and inserting “April 1,
9 2006”.

10 (c) EXTENSION OF EFFECTIVE DATE LIMITATION
11 ON HIGHER TEACHER LOAN FORGIVENESS BENEFITS.—

12 (1) AMENDMENT.—Paragraph (3) of section
13 3(b) of the Taxpayer-Teacher Protection Act of
14 2004 (Public Law 108–409; 20 U.S.C. 1078–10
15 note) is amended by striking “October 1, 2005” and
16 inserting “June 30, 2007”.

17 (2) TECHNICAL AMENDMENT.—Section 2 of
18 such Act is amended by inserting “of the Higher
19 Education Act of 1965” after “438(b)(2)(B)”.

20 (d) EFFECTIVE DATES.—

21 (1) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided in para-
22 graph (2), the amendments made by this section are
23 effective upon enactment.

1 (2) EXCEPTION.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (c)(1) shall take effect as if enacted on
3 October 1, 2005.
