## A BILL

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MAYOR JOHN THOMPSON “TOM” GARRISON ME-**  
4 **MORIAL POST OFFICE.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States  
6 Postal Service located at 1 Boyden Street in Badin, North

1 Carolina, shall be known and designated as the “Mayor  
2 John Thompson ‘Tom’ Garrison Memorial Post Office”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-  
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United  
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall  
6 be deemed to be a reference to the “Mayor John Thomp-  
7 son ‘Tom’ Garrison Memorial Post Office”.
