## A BILL

Making supplemental appropriations for fiscal year 2006 for the Small Business Administration's disaster loans program, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3       That the following sums are appropriated, out of any  
4       money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for fis-  
5       cal year 2006:

1                   SMALL BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION  
2                   DISASTER LOANS PROGRAM ACCOUNT  
3                   (INCLUDING TRANSFER OF FUNDS)

4           For an additional amount for “Disaster Loans Pro-  
5 gram Account” for the cost of direct loans authorized by  
6 section 7(b) of the Small Business Act, \$712,000,000, to  
7 remain available until expended: *Provided*, That such  
8 costs, including the cost of modifying such loans, shall be  
9 as defined in section 502 of the Congressional Budget Act  
10 of 1974: *Provided further*, That the amount provided  
11 under this heading is hereby derived by transfer from the  
12 amount provided for “Disaster Relief” in Public Law 109–  
13 62: *Provided further*, That the amount provided under this  
14 heading is designated as an emergency requirement pursu-  
15 ant to section 402 of H. Con. Res. 95 (109th Congress),  
16 the concurrent resolution on the budget for fiscal year  
17 2006.
