AN ACT

To replace a Coastal Barrier Resources System map relating to Coastal Barrier Resources System Grayton Beach Unit FL-95P in Walton County, Florida.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. REPLACEMENT OF COASTAL BARRIER RE-**
2 **SOURCES SYSTEM MAP RELATING TO**
3 **GRAYTON BEACH UNIT FL-95P IN WALTON**
4 **COUNTY, FLORIDA.**

5 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—The map described in subsection
6 (b) relating to the Coastal Barrier Resources System unit
7 Grayton Beach Unit FL-95P, located in Walton County,
8 Florida, as included in the set of maps entitled “Coastal
9 Barrier Resources System” referred to in section 4(a) of
10 the Coastal Barrier Resources Act (16 U.S.C. 3503(a)),
11 is hereby replaced by another map relating to that unit
12 entitled “Grayton Beach Unit FL-95P and Draper Lake
13 Unit FL-96” and dated “July 24, 2006”.

14 (b) **REPLACED MAP DESCRIBED.**—The map replaced
15 under subsection (a) is subtitled “COASTAL BARRIER
16 RESOURCES SYSTEM GRAYTON BEACH UNIT
17 FL-95P DRAPER LAKE UNIT FL-96” and dated Oc-
18 tober 24, 1990.

19 (c) **AVAILABILITY.**—The Secretary of the Interior
20 shall keep the maps referred to in subsections (a) on file
21 and available for inspection in accordance with the provi-

1 sions of section 4(b) of the Coastal Barrier Resources Act
2 (16 U.S.C. 3503(b)).
