A BILL

To amend the Railroad Retirement Act of 1974 to provide for continued payment of railroad retirement annuities by the Department of the Treasury, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Railroad Retirement
3 Technical Improvement Act of 2006”.

4 **SEC. 2. DISBURSEMENT AGENT.**

5 Section 7(b)(4) of the Railroad Retirement Act of
6 1974 (45 U.S.C. 231f(b)(4)) is amended so that subpara-
7 graph (A) reads as follows:

8 “(A) The Secretary of the Treasury shall
9 serve as the disbursing agent for benefits pay-
10 able under this Act, under such rules and regu-
11 lations as the Secretary may in the Secretary’s
12 discretion prescribe.”.
