A BILL

To provide for the conveyance of the former Konnarock Lutheran Girls School in Smyth County, Virginia, which is currently owned by the United States and administered by the Forest Service, to facilitate the restoration and reuse of the property, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LAND CONVEYANCE, FORMER KONNAROCK LU-**
4 **THERAN GIRLS SCHOOL, JEFFERSON NA-**
5 **TIONAL FOREST, SMYTH COUNTY, VIRGINIA.**

6 (a) CONVEYANCE REQUIRED.—The Secretary of Ag-
7 riculture shall convey, without consideration, to the Evan-

1 gelical Lutheran Coalition for Mission in Appalachia (in
2 this section referred to as the “recipient”) all right, title,
3 and interest of the United States in and to a parcel of
4 real property in the Jefferson National Forest, Smyth
5 County, Virginia, located at the junction of Virginia
6 Routes 600 and 603, consisting of approximately 10 acres,
7 and containing the former Konnarock Lutheran Girls
8 School and its outbuildings.

9 (b) CONDITION OF CONVEYANCE.—The conveyance
10 under subsection (a) shall be subject to the condition that
11 the recipient accept the real property described in such
12 subsection in its condition at the time of the conveyance,
13 commonly known as conveyance “as is”.

14 (c) DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY.—The exact acreage
15 and legal description of the real property to be conveyed
16 under subsection (a) shall be determined by a survey satis-
17 factory to the Secretary. The cost of the survey shall be
18 borne by the recipient.

19 (d) ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS.—The
20 Secretary may require such additional terms and condi-
21 tions in connection with the conveyance under subsection
22 (a) as the Secretary considers appropriate to protect the
23 interests of the United States.
