3 **SECTION 1. JOSHUA A. TERANDO PRINCETON POST OFFICE**
4 **BUILDING.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
6 Postal Service located at 202 East Washington Street in

1 Morris, Illinois, shall be known and designated as the
2 “Joshua A. Terando Princeton Post Office Building”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the “Joshua A. Terando
7 Princeton Post Office Building”.
